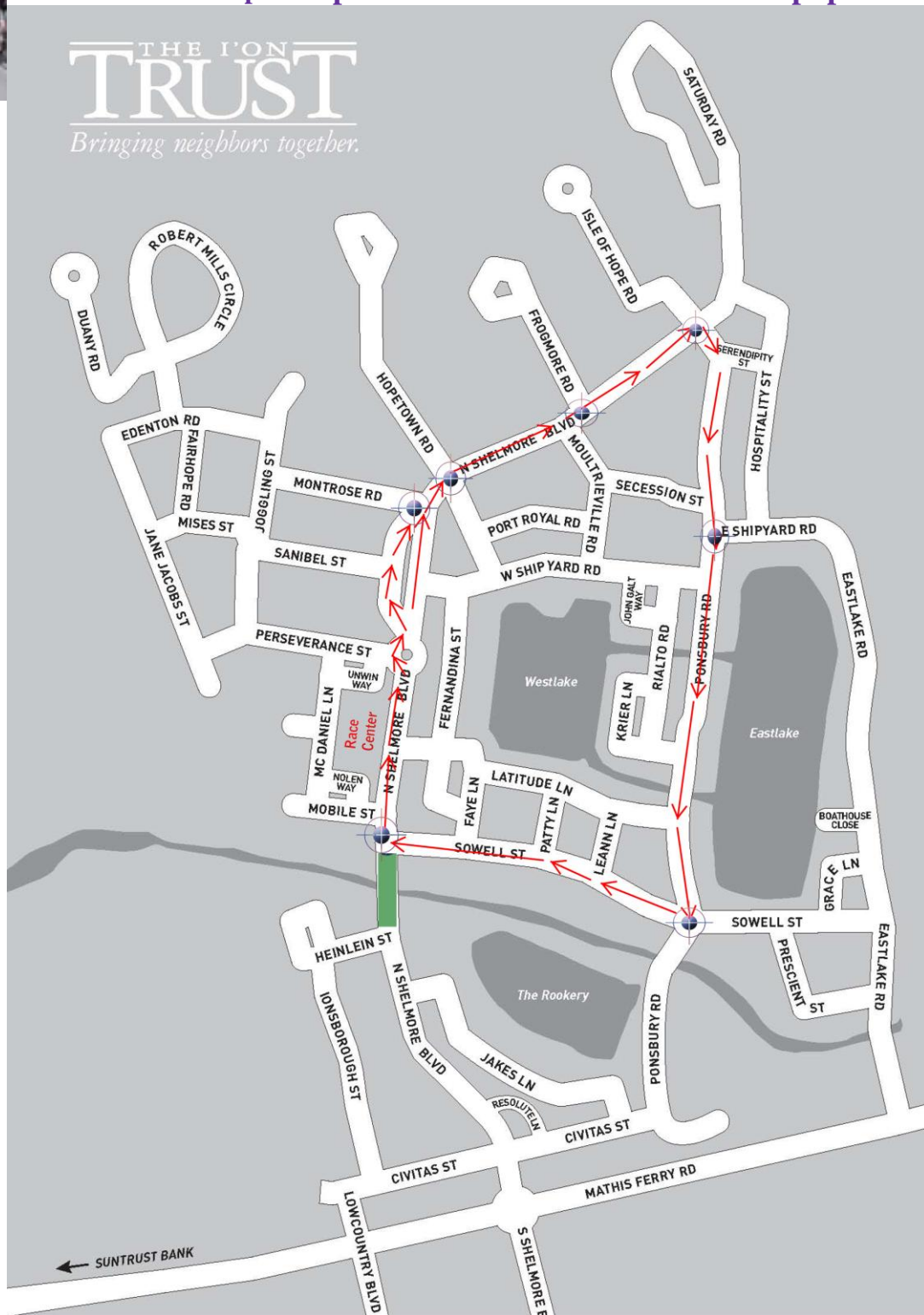




I'On Bicycle Circuit Race Course and Street Access Map 6 am to 6 pm, April 16, 2011

NOTICE OF STREET CLOSURES IN I'ON SAT. APRIL 16, 2011 The SOWELL Street to SHELMORE to PONSBURY to SOWELL Street bicycle race course marked on the opposite side of this notice will be closed to vehicular traffic and on street parking on April 16, 2011 from 6 am to 6 pm. Only very limited opportunities for vehicular crossing of these street sections will be available. Vehicles parked on the street after 5 am, April 16 will be towed at Owner's expense. Ingress and Egress for Residents during the Race

We would like to thank the I'On Assembly Board for approving this event and the Town of Mt. Pleasant for their support in the permitting process. We would also like to thank the residents of I'On for their support and willingness to help us make the race work here. The Bike Race is a great day of fun and drama. With some patience and cooperation, it can be a great day for everyone.

Mt. Pleasant police officers are positioned at the locations of the four pointed stars to help you cross the street when necessary during the gaps when the pack is elsewhere on the course. On street parking is also not permitted along the course during the race for safety reasons.

A single lane in front of Holy Ascension Orthodox Church at the intersection of Sowell Street and Shelmore Blvd. will be open for traffic. Cars will have to take turns, under police supervision using this single lane. This lane is meant to serve the Northwest part of I'On, West of Shelmore, North of Mobile and West of Hopetown Road. It can be accessed by driving to the West of Maybank Green and on Mobile Street, the street on the North Side of the Church.

New this year. No parking will be allowed on N. Shelmore between Sowell and Heinlein to lessen the congestion in this area.

On street parking within I'On on streets not part of the course must be inside the spaces designated with the "T" shaped white space markers.. If you park on the street outside of the marked spaces you may be fined or towed. Guests should park in the marked spaces, on the alleys, off street, in your driveway, around the I'On Square or in the parking lots at the BI-LO Shopping center. Individuals officially associated with the event may have printed on street parking passes for the undeveloped part of I'On NW of Maybank Field. For more details see www.ionbiznet.com.

Anyone needing to drive across or through the race course must cross the course at the locations marked with the blue circles, when permitted by police.

Most people living on or inside the course will need to plan to cross near the intersection of Ponsbury and East Shipyard marked "best crossing point" on the map.

Delays may be significant. In many cases, it may be easier to park your car outside the race course on Friday evening and just walk to your car on Saturday. Guests coming to porch parties to watch the race should park near the I'On Square or at BI-LO or elsewhere outside the course and walk to the party.

Large vehicles or trucks may not be able to cross the course on race day.

In the event of a major emergency, racing will be suspended to permit emergency vehicle access. The Town's Police Dispatchers are aware of this event and will be able to contact the officers on site.

Representatives of the Police Department will be in the neighborhood all day supervising traffic and attending to public safety concerns. The cost of these officers is being paid by the race organizers.
